DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Share with the group: If you woke up tomorrow as an animal, what animal would you choose to be and why?
- 2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
- 3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck's message this week?
- 4. Read Isaiah 29:13; Give some examples of how people today are guilty of doing what this verse talks about.
- 5. Read Isaiah 30:1,8; In this chapter, Isaiah warns the people of Judah that they are making plans without consulting God. How do we today make plans without consulting God first? Share a personal story if you can.
- 6. Read 2 Samuel 5:19: Describe a time when you consulted God first before doing something? How can we do this practically individually and as a Church?
- 7. Read Isaiah 31:1-2; What are the things today that people are trusting in? What have you been trusting in more than you should?

8. Read Isaiah 34:11-15. God is the God of love and God is also a God who will judge. Have you ever been asked how a loving God can judge? How does one get their name written in the book of life?

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9. Read Isaiah 35:1-2. What will the land be like during the millennial reign of Christ?
