Overview of Campus Safety Plan

Guiding Principles and Requirements

- “We will take required and prudent measures to protect our most at-risk people including those with underlying health conditions, our senior citizens and people with disabilities”
- Pastor Chuck has shared that we are committed to resuming indoor gatherings safely. We are going to be *safe, safe, safe!*

Campus Safety Protocols

- **Hand sanitizing stations** available for use
- **Face coverings** and/or masks will be required to access the Worship Center
 - Masks will be available to those who arrive without one
- **Physical distancing:** Maintain 6 ft physical distancing between social groups
 - Walk-paths as people enter and exit
 - Crowd management and seating plan arrangements have been developed for those attending services indoors
- **Self-screening** symptom check signage
 - Covid-19 symptoms are posted to raise awareness and for quick, personal health screenings
- **Temperature check** prior to entry to the Worship Center
- **Cleaning and disinfecting** processes
 - Antimicrobial film installed in handles and doors
 - Electrostatic sprayers for disinfection. Don't be alarmed - we use products that are safe for us!
 - Barrier devices used in specific locations around the church and school campus
 - Developed a rigorous cleaning process for bathrooms and other high traffic areas that follows CDC guidelines
- **Additional signage** will be around campus to remind people arriving of the safety measures

- Space turnover
 - Seating plan:
 - Every other row seating
