

Crossroads Camper Guidelines

Each parent is responsible to discuss the camper guidelines listed below with their child prior to camp.

- All meetings, meals and activities are mandatory.
- Campers are to stay within the designated camp boundaries.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- No one is to leave their cabin after “lights out” unless accompanied by another camper or counselor.
- Campers should never enter anybody’s cabin but their own, unless accompanied by a counselor.
- Campers are always to show respect toward other campers, counselors, and camp staff, as well as the camp facilities.
- Absolutely no drugs, alcohol, tobacco, firearms, radios, knives, iPods, phones, devices or electronic games are allowed at camp.
- There is absolutely no raiding of other cabins or any form of pranks allowed.
- There is no phone available for camper use throughout the weekend. Campers are also not to bring or use their cell phones during camp. This includes Apple Watches or smart watches.
- Parents will be charged for any deliberate damage to camp property done by the camper.
- There is to be no display of physical affection (i.e. hand holding, kissing, etc.) to those of the opposite sex at any time during camp.
